  - Oregon Residents
  - Veterans
- Juniors or Seniors
- College of Forestry, Fisheries and Wildlife or Natural Resources with FW emphasis

## **Roland E. Dimick Memorial Scholarship – 2 awards**

- Sophomore who has been in the Department for at least 3 terms
- Award is based on Freshman year performance

## **Fritzell Diversity Scholarship**

- Fulltime student in FW
- Ethnic minority, low income status, or documented disability

## **Howard Horton Fisheries Management Scholarship**

- Fulltime sophomore or junior
- Career interest in fisheries management
- Evidence of leadership, volunteer activities, and potential for successful career
- Demonstrated financial need

## **Lee Wallace Kuhn Memorial Scholarship**

- Fulltime junior or senior
- Emphasis in wildlife
- GPA range of 2.5 to 3.3
